VisionHeartBeat

If you use a Navision Application Server, this is the add-on you can't live without! **Vision**HeartBeat helps you monitor and manage your Navision Application Server - and restarts the application automatically whenever it's not responding!

With **Vision**HeartBeat the administrator gets an alert the moment things are not going as planned. Information is logged on the Windows Event Log – and you can also choose to get the alerts by email.

VisionHeartBeat service can restart Navision Application servers automatically if they are not responding.

Create your own settings - for example:

- Specify how many seconds a message is allowed to be positioned in a message queue before it is picked up by the Navision Application Server. When the timeout is reached the Application Server will be restarted.
- Specify how many seconds there can be between two heartbeats (a Heartbeat is an UDP packet send by the Application Server to the Heartbeat Service).
- Monitor several Application Servers with the **Vision**HeartBeat Service.
- Configure the service to send an e-mail when an error occurs, e.g. when the Application Server has been restarted. It is also up to you if you want an e-mail when a noncritical situation occurs. You can add multiple e-mail addresses to the service.

With **Vision**HeartBeat you can keep an eye on your Navision Application Server – anytime and anywhere! The users will observe fewer breakdowns as the application will restart automatically after a few seconds when the system is not responding
